Deposition of *Spinturnix* Paratypes (Acarina: Spinturnicidae).

Paratypes of 4 species of *Spinturnix* have been transferred from the author's collection to the Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle, Paris, the Field Museum of Natural History, Chicago, and the California Academy of Sciences, San Francisco.

The specimens transferred are listed here along with the type specimens originally deposited in the United States National Museum, Washington, D. C., at the time the descriptions were published.

Spinturnix orri Rudick, 1960.

Paris: 2 females, paratypes.

Chicago: I female and I male, paratypes.

San Francisco: I female and I male, paratypes.

Washington: I female holotype and I male allotype.

Spinturnix multisetosus Rudcnick, 1960.

Paris: I female and I male, paratypes.

Chicago: 2 males, paratypes.

San Francisco: I female, I male, and I nymph, paratypes. Washington: I female holotype and I male allotype.

Spinturnix bakeri Rudnick, 1960.

Paris: I female and I nymph, paratypes. Chicago: I female and I nymph, paratypes.

San Francisco: I female, I male, 2 nymphs, paratypes, and I gravid female not designated as a type specimen but from the same collection as the type specimens.

Washington: I female holotype, I male allotype, and I female and I male paratype.

Spinturnix mexicanus Rudnick, 1960.

Paris: 3 females and 5 males, paratypes. Chicago: 3 females and 5 males, paratypes.

San Francisco: 4 females, 7 males, and 5 nymphs, paratypes.

Washington: I female holotype, I male allotype, and I female and I male paratype.
